



How UBC courses are delivered

In the [Course Schedule](#), each course activity will show a “Delivery Mode”, which describes how each individual component (e.g., lecture, lab, tutorial, discussion) within a course is going to be delivered.

UBC offers the following course Delivery Modes:

- **In-Person:** The course activity takes place in-person.
- **Online:** The course activity is fully online and does not require any in-person attendance to complete.
- **Hybrid:** The course activity has a mixture of mandatory in-person and online activities as designed by the instructor.
- **Multi-Access:** The course activity gives students the choice to attend either in person or online, as designed by the instructor.

In some courses, one activity may be delivered online while another activity is in-person, so simply selecting “online”, “hybrid”, or “multi-access” as the Delivery Mode for a course does not guarantee that all the course elements are fully online. For example, a course may have an online lecture, with the lab component conducted on campus.
